1. School Restructuring

- Junior High School: Headed by Mr. Jolaoso David.
- Senior High School: Managed by Mr. Chimaobi J.J.

2. Introduction of the Contractor

The contractor managing the Nursery and Primary School segment of Weenoble International School was formally introduced on the 22nd of November. He is now responsible for the day-to-day management of the Nursery and Primary section under our close supervision.

3. Inauguration of the Parent-Teacher Forum (PTF)

8. Tuition Adjustment for Next Term
